Possible link to Science - Healthy eating and literacy - persuasion</p> <p>Focus on advertising. Children could create posters, leaflets, adverts for packaging.</p> <p>Slogans and lettering - use publisher for design.</p> <p>Study Andy Warhol - Look at repeat patterns - Campbell's Soup Tin to recreate own design in a similar style.</p> <p>Experiment with printing techniques.</p>	<p>Use artefacts, books and photographs for inspiration plus The Staffordshire Hoard.</p> <p>Ideas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Weaving and braiding • Jewellery • Masks/helmets • Create drawings and paintings of myths and legends.
