What is a minor injury?

Staff at the MIU treat patients of all ages for:

- Bites
- Cuts and lacerations
- Foreign bodies in the eyes, nose & ears
- Assessment of fractures
- Minor burns and scalds
- Minor head injuries (with no loss of consciousness)
- Soft tissue injuries, for example sprains and bruises
- Wound infections
