promote the good name of the school within the community.

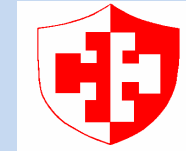

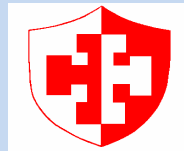

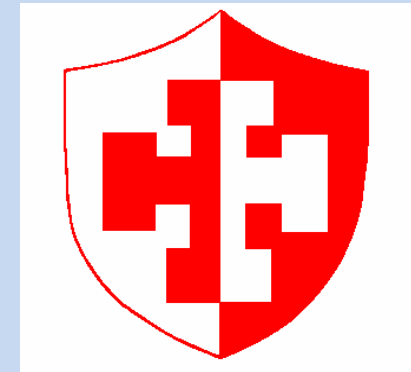
