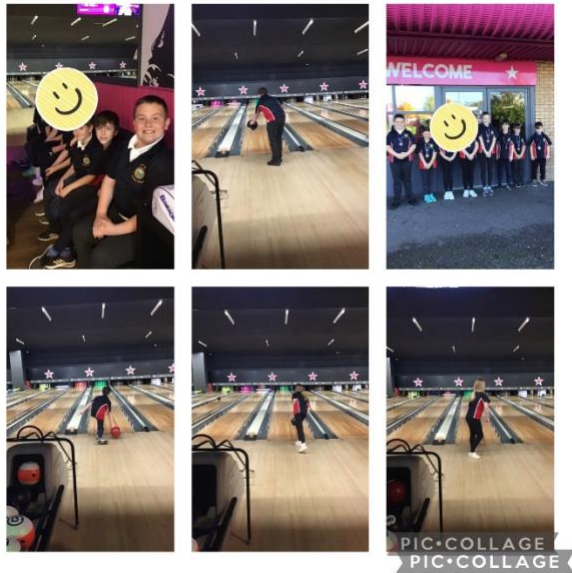


We enjoyed great success at The Tag Rugby Tournament held at Thomas Adams, Wem.
