

Possible ways of helping your child this term:

- Talk about what they have enjoyed at school
- Share stories from home or their 'love to read' school book and talk about the characters and events.
- Support children reading their phonics book independently (after half term) at least once a week.
- Practise counting to 20. Count out objects like dolls, cars, building blocks and say how many there is.
- Ensure children carry out essential daily routines like using the toilet, brushing teeth, getting dressed and washing hands independently.
- Talk about how old children are and when their birthday is.
- Talk like a robot to develop important skills for reading and writing (s-o-ck/ c-ar/ d-o-ll/ l-e-g)
- Practise letter sounds and words that we have been learning.

**PE: Tuesday and Friday**

(House colour t-shirt, black or navy shorts or joggers and jacket, Velcro trainers.) Please do not send children to school with laces unless they can tie them independently.

**Outdoor learning: Thursday**

(Long-sleeve top, trousers, waterproofs. Wellies will be kept in school for playtimes and outdoor learning).

We will be outside in all sorts of weathers so please ensure your child has appropriate clothing.
