English

Children will be able to develop positive attitudes towards and stamina for writing by:

- writing narratives about personal experiences and those of others linked to our topic of 'Mini beasts' and 'The Seaside'.
- consider what they are going to write before beginning by: planning or saying out loud what they are going to write about writing down ideas and/or key words, including new vocabulary;
- encapsulating what they want to say, sentence by sentence;
- make simple additions, revisions and corrections to their own writing;
- use capital letters for names of people and places;
- write factual sentences with conjunctions about minibeasts;
- add more detail to sentences by using e.g. expanded noun phrases;
- form all letters using the correct pattern and increasingly, join handwriting.

Mathematics

- read and write numbers to at least 100;
- recognise the place value of tens and ones in a 2-digit number;
- count to 100 forwards and backwards and from different starting points;
- count forwards and backwards in 2s, 5s and 10s;
- know addition facts within 10 and 20;
- subtract by 'taking away'.
- understand multiplication and division in terms of equal grouping;
- write simple fractions; know the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Science- Living Things and Their habitats

The children will be learning about:

- Living and non-living things including mini beasts.
- Habitats in our locality.
- Habitats around the world.
- Food Chains.

Geography – Countryside to Coast

Our theme this term will centre on exploring our locality (Prees and Whitchurch) and investigating how it contrasts with a seaside locality (Rhyl). We will:

- investigate maps and mapping seeing things from above using Google Earth;
- recognise and use map symbols;
- find out what types of shops and businesses do we have in Prees and Whitchurch?
- find out what is the same and what is different about the shops and businesses in Rhyl.
- experience a Day trip to Rhyl, to explore the locality, visit the Lifeboat station and enjoy the beach.
