

## English

- Say and write a series of simple sentences, punctuating correctly with capital letters and full stops.
- Continue to represent the sounds heard in words with letters.
- Revisit Phase 5 phonemes and blend the sounds to read words.
- Predict what might happen next in the stories Jack and the Flumflum Tree and Grandad's Island
- Form all letters using the correct pattern with clear ascenders and descenders.
- Begin to add more detail and description to sentences.
- Begin to understand past and present tense.

## Mathematics

- Skip count in 2s and 5s from 0 forwards and backwards.
- Rapidly recall one more and one less within 20.
- Secure number bonds to ten and use to confidently calculate and solve problems.
- **Explore ways of presenting addition of three numbers within 10**
- Develop addition and subtraction across ten.
- Explore difference as a form of subtraction.
- Tell and write the times for o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past.

## Science- Ourselves and our senses.

- Name and label parts of the body.
- Know the five senses.
- Ask scientific questions and think about ways to answer them.
- Explore how seasons change from Summer to Autumn.

## Humanities- Off we go!- Exploring modes of transport and how they have changed throughout history.



Our topic centres on the history of transport, bikes, boats, trains and aeroplanes and how they have changed through time. We will look at significant events and journeys as well as our own every day travels. We will be visiting some local places where journeys and modes of transport can be seen.

- Know where we live and locate London, Shropshire and Prees on a map of the UK.
- Talk about journeys we have been on and how we can travel to places.
- Look at the changes in methods of transport and how modes of transport have changed over time.
- Know about the Wright Brothers' first flight as a significant events in History.
