

## English

- Say and write a simple sentence leaving finger spaces.
- Represent the sounds heard in words with letters.
- Orally rehearse and retell familiar stories.
- Revisit Phase 3 phonemes and blend the sounds to read words.
- Predict what might happen next in a story.
- Form all letters using the correct pattern.

## Mathematics

- Count to 100 and back from different starting points.
- Recall one more and less than a number within 10.
- Confidently recall number bonds to 5 and use to calculate and solve problems.
- Look at number 6-10 as 5 and a bit more.
- Begin to learn number bonds to 10.
- Identify and reason about odd and even numbers.
- Know the days of the week.

## Science- Ourselves and our senses.

- Name and label parts of the body.
- Know the five senses.
- Ask scientific questions and think about ways to answer them.
- Explore how seasons change from Summer to Autumn to Winter.

## Humanities- Off We Go! Exploring journeys and modes of transport.



*Our topic centres on the history of transport and how transport and its use have changed over time. We will visit some local places where modes of transport can be seen.*

- Know where we live and locate London, Shropshire and Prees on a map of the UK.
- Talk about journeys we have been on and how we can travel to places.
- Look at the changes in methods of transport and how modes of transport have changed over time.
- Know about the Wright Brothers' first flight as significant event in History.

- Talk about how to overcome obstacles.

### Music

- Learn simple songs.
- Accompany a song by playing a steady beat.
- Listen to and say what we think about a piece of music.
- Create soundscapes using body and other percussions.

### Art and Design

- Explore Van Gogh's Seascapes.
- Create shades and tints of colour.
- Compose our own Seascapes using a variety of media.

### Design Technology

- Explore a range of moving vehicles and how they work.
- Design and build a model vehicle with wheels and axels.
- Evaluate our own designs.

- How do Christians share the good news that Jesus brings?
- Learn why Christmas matters to Christians.

### Computing

- Learning how to login and navigate around a computer; developing mouse skills; learning how to drag, drop, click and control a cursor to create works of art

- Learn to balance and show co-ordination in movement.

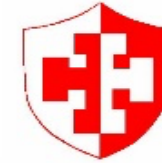
