

Possible ways of helping your child this term:

- Listen to your child read their phonics book at least once a week.
- Practise counting to 20. Count out objects like dolls, cars, building blocks and say how many there is. Make sure children 'tag' each object with a number for accurate counting.
- Ensure children carry out essential daily routines like using the toilet, brushing teeth, getting dressed and washing hands independently.
- Ask Why/ How questions to initiate an appropriate response.
- Practise letter sounds and words that we have been learning.
- Encourage children to use a knife and fork independently at home to cut and eat their food.
- Talk about numbers and number patterns.
- Talk about how they can contribute to looking after the by recycling and picking up litter.

(House colour t-shirt, black or navy shorts or joggers and jacket, Velcro trainers.) Please do not send children to school with laces unless they can tie them independently.

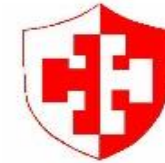
Outdoor learning: Thursday
