****School Uniform****

We will be working closely with families to ensure a strict uniform code is adhered to by everyone.

Our school uniform is as follows:

Grey trousers/shorts or skirt/pinafore

White polo shirt / blouse or shirt

Navy blue jumper or cardigan (**with or without the school logo on it**)

Black shoes for boys and girls ****(no sandals or trainers)****

Light blue and white checked dress

**** Plain stud earrings and /or a watch can be worn, no other jewellery please. ****

For PE:

Navy blue shorts/skort or navy/black jogging bottoms (no logos/slogans/writing on)

Plain red, blue or yellow round neck T-shirt (**with or without the school logo on it**)

Plain navy/black sweatshirt or track suit top (no logos/slogans/writing on)

Trainers for all children

Spare socks

****Please note school jumpers/cardigans and PE t-shirts do not need to have the school logo on them****

**** Your child will need to remove or cover their earrings for swimming lessons and either remove them or put tape over them for PE please. ****

Can we please ask that you do not send your child in different coloured jogging bottoms and sweat-shirt/track suit top other than navy or black and that they do not have any writing, slogans, logos etc on them. If you do not have a plain navy or black sweatshirt, we are more than happy for your child to wear their navy school jumper/cardigan on top of their yellow, red or blue t-shirt for PE.

If your child should forget to come dressed in their PE kit we do have kits in school that your child can borrow to allow them to take part in the PE lesson. Thank you for your support.

MESSAGING

Most communications are sent by email or text via ParentPay. Please make sure that you have registered via the details sent home to ensure you receive notifications, letters and news.

Please make sure that we have the most up to date contact information for you. Please let us know of any changes to your key details.

As a matter of routine, any injury above the neck means that a text is sent home as well as the 'bump note'. All other minor accidents will be recorded and a note sent home with your child. If anything is considered more serious than a minor injury we will always ring you.

Child Absence

Please telephone school (01948 840209) by 9.00am if your child is unwell and will not be attending that day. If leaving a message, can you please provide the exact reason why your child is absent.

If we have not heard from you by 9.15am, we will telephone you and follow-up with a text message.

If we have still not heard from you by 10.30am we will telephone and text again as this becomes a safeguarding concern.

We shall also be contacting parents of Nursery children who do not attend, for whatever reason, on days that we are expecting them. This is a health and wellbeing safeguarding check.

Children from 0-5 years, parents, carers, grandparents, friends, we look forward to you joining us on a Wednesday in our school hall.



We would like to remind you of some organisational details which will help the school day to run smoothly and safely for everyone

- 1. The school day begins at 8.45 a.m. The children are supervised on the playground from 8.35 a.m. until 8.45 a.m. by a member of staff. Please remember that the school does not take legal responsibility for the children until they are on the school playground. Collection for Nursery children is at 3pm from outside the Nursery door onto the playground. Collection at 3.15pm for Reception Class and Year 2 is from the door by our Reflection Area onto the playground and Year 1 from their classroom door onto the playground. Year 3 and Year 4 are collected from the Hall door onto the playground. Year 5 and Year 6 from the door next to the blue kitchen door.**
- 2. Children wear their P.E. kit to school on the days they have P.E. During the course of this year, the children will be learning the skills to play a number of sports such as hockey, football, cricket and rounders. If parents/carers feel that it is appropriate for their child to have a mouth guard and shin pads in school for these activities, then can we please ask you to purchase these for your child.**
- 3. Children may wear a watch for school and plain studs if ears are pierced. In the interests of safety and security no other jewellery should be worn. Children will be expected to remove or cover ear rings during swimming lessons and either remove or cover during PE. We appreciate everyone's co-operation in this matter as it is for the children's safety.**
- 4. Braids and beads should not be worn in children's hair. It is not acceptable for the children to have unconventional hair cuts such as 'tramlines' etc.**
- 5. We ask that children do not bring pencil cases from home into school as we do not have space to store them during the school day.**
- 6. Medicines – if your child has to take medication during the school day, we are happy to administer medication, however we do ask that medicines are brought into school office by an adult who we will ask to complete a medication administration form.**
- 7. Can we ask that children bring a water bottle into school each day containing water, which is labelled with their name please.**
- 8. Please ensure that your child adheres to our school uniform code and that all items of clothing are labelled.**

ParentPay - our online payment system in school

ParentPay is our online payment system that is used to make a variety of school payments. Parents/carers can use ParentPay to pay for school payments such as: Dinner Money top ups, Toast, School Trips, Breakfast Club, Wrap Around Club and Swimming etc.

If your child is just starting our school you will receive a code during their first week enabling you to set up an account. Your child will still be able to have a lunch or stay to Breakfast or Wrap Around Club whilst a code is being allocated to you. Children in Reception Class, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to Universal Free School Meals.

If you are not yet using or have mislaid your ParentPay code please contact the office.

Driving up the Lane

Can we please ask, for everyone's safety, that you do not drive your car up the lane to school when dropping off and collecting your child from school for Breakfast Club or Wrap Around. Thank you.

Breakfast Club and Wrap Around Club

We have a daily Breakfast Club (during term time) from 7.45am. Breakfast is supplied and the children are taken to join their classes at 8.40am. The cost for the daily session is £4 payable via ParentPay. If you are able, we ask that your book in advance but the club is also available on an ad hoc basis to suit your needs.

Wrap Around Club (during term time) runs from 3.10pm—6pm daily. The cost is £4 per hourly session, payable via ParentPay. A snack can be provided if your child is staying after 5.10pm for an additional cost of £1, you need to let us know in advance if you would like this please.

Again, if you are able, we ask you to book in advance but the club is also available on an ad hoc basis to suit your needs.

Both clubs are for children aged 3 years and above. Vouchers can be used to pay for Breakfast and/or Wrap Around Club.

School Meals

Hot school meals are available daily at a cost of £2.55 (£1.75 for Nursery children) and payable via ParentPay.

Please note children moving into Year 3 will need to pay for school lunches.

Your child may be entitled to free school meals if you are in receipt of certain benefits. Please apply, if you are eligible, for children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 even though they will receive universal free school meals. Please visit the site below to check if you are eligible to apply.

Toast

Toast is available to the children at first playtime at a cost of 10p per slice, this is payable via ParentPay.

Children in Nursery, Reception and Key Stage 1 have free fruit on a daily basis.

**** Please let us know if you do not want your child to have toast on a daily basis as some of our children may not understand and may order without you knowing. ****

Children are more than welcome to bring in their own healthy snacks, i.e. raw vegetables, fruit etc. to eat at playtime. Thank you.

**** School Transport ****

Your child may be eligible for school transport if they are in Reception Class to Year 6 and fulfil certain criteria.
